Master of Education (M.Ed.):

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) Programme is a two-year professional programme in the field of Teacher Education which aims at preparing teacher educators and other education professionals including curriculum developers, educational policy analysts, planners, administrators, supervisors, school principals and researchers. The completion of the programme shall lead to M.Ed. degree with specialization either in elementary education (upto class VIII) or in secondary education (classes VI-VII).

Duration:

The M.Ed. programme shall be of duration of two academic years including field attachment for a minimum of 4 weeks and research dissertation. Students shall be permitted to complete the programme requirements of the twoyear programme within a maximum period of three years from the date of admission to the programme. The summer should be used for field attachment/practicum/other activities.

Attendance :

The minimum attendance of student-teachers shall be 80% for all course work including practicum, and 90% for Field Attachment.
